CAMDEN JUNIOR BOWLS ACADEMY

Camden Bowling Club Junior Academy is available to all players between the ages of 10 and 18 who wish to become a member of Camden Bowling Club. To be a participant in our Academy program and to remain as a part of our Academy, Camden Bowling Club would expect a certain level of commitment from its players. This would include:

- 1. Become a Junior Bowling member of Camden Bowling Club
- 2. Make an effort to attend training and/or coaching sessions as requested by the coaches. This would include a commitment to at least one training session per week.
- 3. Make themselves available for selection in the High School Lawn Bowls team and when required for Zone or State Championships
- 4. Be available to compete in events recommended by our coaches, which would of course be subject to the students other commitments
- 5. Be available for occasional promotional activities if requested by relative sponsors. Allow for the use of photographs in newspaper articles, newsletters, and the promotion of our Junior Academy and on our website.
- 6. Conduct themselves in an acceptable manner both at the Bowling Club and whilst away representing the club.
- 7. Present themselves well and display a positive behaviour and attitude.
- 8. Be punctual and display a high level of Etiquette and Sportsmanship on and off the green.
- 9. Complete and adhere to the Club Code of Conduct.
- 10. Adhere to the Club and NSW Dress Regulations.
- 11. Comply with instruction from management in line with the club constitution and the Registered Clubs Act.
- 12. Adhere to instructions from coaches or their delegates
- 13. Notify coaches or Camden Bowling Club staff of non-attendance or lateness.
- 14. Maintain all equipment and clothing in good order

All Academy Players will be provided with Junior Club Shirt, Pants and Cap at no charge. These may need to be returned to the club if the player decides to leave the Academy or is no longer an eligible player.

While a member of the Academy Membership Fees will be subsidised by Camden Bowling Club.

Academy Players have access to the Club bowls stored in the Coaches locker. These bowls can be taken to events and used for the time the player remains in the Academy.

Training days are to be determined. During school holidays, club coaches will be available for private training. Training days may be affected by inclement weather and availability of green space due to club events. Academy Players will receive coaching from qualified coaches and can organise private coaching with any of our coaching staff at an agreeable time.

Before accepting a position in our Academy, we need to know that you and your parents/guardian have read and understand the conditions of becoming an Academy player.

It is also very important that parents/guardian understand that they are required to ensure that students attending coaching sessions have suitable arrangements in place, to and from the club.
