# MINOR PAIRS CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Minor Pairs may be contested by Members of the GMBC +CWBC

Who have NOT won a Major or Minor Pairs championship at any club.

- Four bowl conventional pairs
- Games may be scheduled Saturday, Sunday or both depending on number of entries, am, pm or both as required.
- Cards called 20 minutes before, and rollups completed by start time.
- There is no order of precedence for this event.
- One rollup each way
- 18 ENDS
- Re-spotting the jack If a jack in motion passes completely outside the boundaries of the rink or rebounds to a distance less than 14m from the mat line the end shall not be declared dead, but the jack re-spotted on the 2m mark.

#### **UNABLE TO PLAY**

All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e. the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser.

- Controlling body for the event is the match committee present.
- All decisions made by the controlling body regarding this competition shall be final.
- The controlling body shall have the right to change the conditions of play to ensure there is a finish to the event by a suitable date.

#### **UNABLE TO PLAY**

- There is no order of precedence for this event, should you be unable to play on
   The scheduled date or as stated in these COPs for any reason,
   A substitute Must be found.
- All matches are to be played under the Club's "play or forfeit" rule i.e. play on or before the due date. However, where circumstances prevail a bowler or team can request the game be played before the next scheduled round. If mutual agreement is reached the player / team requesting the extension must notify the Bowls Organiser. (If this is not done the game will be invalid) If under any circumstances the game is not completed by the scheduled date (i.e., the next round) the player / team requesting the extension forfeits the game and notifies the Bowls Organiser and Match Committee.
